


FOREWORD

To The Student Body:



Beverly, who was a ninth grade student passed, May 19, 1962, at the age of 14.


The effects of her influence are beyond our imagination. Her face was always covered with smiles. From within her came the impressive attitude, "Everyone should strive to do his best."


