"Bold Pilgrim Missionary Baptist Church organized in 1904 called 3 pastors in charge until 1914 Then I took charge of the church Jan. 1, 1914. Remodeled in 1924, by present pastor Rev. W. T. Vanhook. Officers J. S. Madison, C. J. Johnson, W. M. Johnson, C. L. Robinson, J. W. Williams, H. N. Netter CR"
