## HARVEY GRAVE

### Tishomingo, Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Harvey Grave was surveyed by Betty Marlar and Judy Walker on September 23, 1996, for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher on November 4, 2005.

Location: Go to Highway 25 north from Tishomingo to Highway 30 east, go approximately five miles. This grave is located near Ed Wares' home on the right side of the road.

**Southward**, Harvey Margaret d. 05/15/1908 Age about 63 years\* Broken monument

This is reportedly the Southward Family Cemetery, containing graves of the Southward family and the Southward slave families. No other markers found, however this site is very near an intersection, road work could have destroyed them years ago.
