## OLD EASTPORT CEMETERY

### Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Old Eastport Cemetery was surveyed by Shorty Bonds, Leon Johnson, and Judy Walker on October 3, 1996, for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher on December 4, 2005.

**Location:** Take Eastport Road (County Road 956) approximately 8.5 miles to County Road 263. Turn left onto County Road 263, drive approximately 0.6 of a mile, and turn right onto County Road 267; continue driving for approximately one mile. The woods on the right were previously cut over. Walk through this area and into deep woods. The cemetery is located approximately 75 feet into the woods on the left side of an old road. Township 2, Range 11, Section 22.
