The following information was obtained from the minute books of the Sardis Primitive Baptist Church for the year of 1892 on pages 53 and 54.

The Sardis Church met in conference on the Saturday before the first Sunday in June 1892. Prayer was led by Elder J. C. Reed and business proceedings began.

First: Called for the peace of the church. All in peace.

Second: Invited visiting brethren and sisters to seats with us.

Third: Called for reference. No reference.

Fourth: Proclaimed the doors of the church open for the reception of members. None received.

Fifth: By request of the brethren and sisters around Berea Church that want letters of dismissal for the purpose of constituting a church at Berea. The names that requested letters for that purpose are: J. G. Stepp, Milton Hardwick and wife, J. R. Streetman and wife, and F. E. Holder and M. F. Holder.

Sixth: Moved and seconded that the church grant letters of dismissal. Vote taken and letters granted.

Seventh: Closed in peace.
