The Dean graves were surveyed by Chuck Dean, Bobby Walker, and Judy Walker on September 29, 1996, for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher on November 4, 2005.

<u>Driving Directions</u>: From Highway 25 north, take County Road 231 (Harmony Road), and then take County Road 226 to the left. Drive 0.1 of a mile past the County Road 22 sign and turn left onto a field road. Walk past a gate 0.75 of a mile to Hazard Cemetery in woods. These graves are approximately 250 feet west of Hazard Cemetery on the next ridge. The cemetery is located on private property.
